The deadline for abstract submission is August 15, 2018. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed and acceptance will be notified by August 30, 2018. The deadline for full paper submission is October 15, 2018. Please mail the full paper to grm@iitg.ac.in. For seminar presentations, papers will be allotted 20 minutes, plus 10 minutes for discussion. Queries related to abstract submission can be sent to

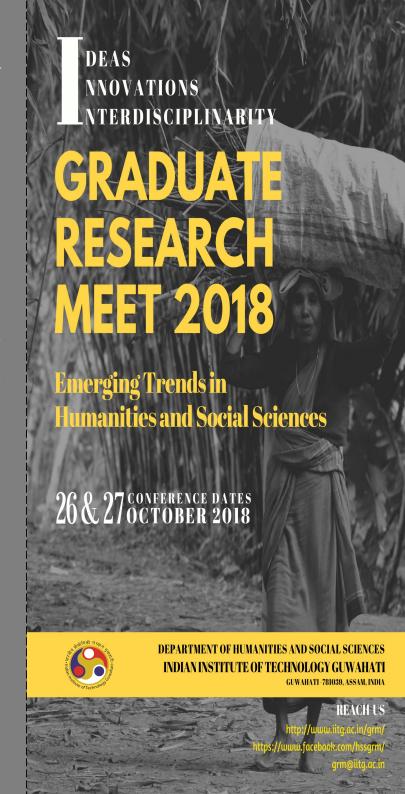
ABOUT THE GRM

ABOUT THE CITY

IIT Guwahati is located on the north bank of the river Brahmaputra 23 kms away from the heart of the city. Guwahati is known as the gateway of North East India, and it is the largest city in the region. Being situated between the bank of the mighty Brahmaputra River and the foothills of the Shillong plateau, the city starts experiencing cold weather from late October and early November. On an average, the daily temperature in Guwahati city varies from 17° C to 28°C during the end of October. The places of tourist attraction which one can explore from Guwahati are Kamakhya temple, Umananda temple, Kaziranga National Park, Manas National Park, Shillong, Cherrapunjee, Tawang and many more.

ACCOMMODATION AND TA
